



Dear Eighth Grade Families:

The Postsecondary Enrollment Options Act (PA 160 or 1996) provides for payment from a school district's state aid foundation grant for enrollment of certain eligible high school students in postsecondary courses of education. The following are some of the eligibility guidelines/standards:

- Students in 9th grade may be eligible for up to 2 courses.
- Students can qualify for dual enrollment by taking one of the following assessments: PSAT, PLAN, EXPLORE ACT, or MME.
- Students must be enrolled in both the eligible school and eligible postsecondary institution during the local school's regular academic year.
- The college courses are those that are not available at our school and need to be in an eligible subject area.

Please review the contents of this letter with your parents. If you believe you are eligible for dual enrollment, or wish to discuss this in more detail, contact school leader Stephanie Kooiker.
